

Deuteronomy: Love From All Generations

Texts: Deut 1:1–5; 1:26–32; 6:4–12; 8:11–18

I. The Setting — Covenant Renewal (Deut 1:1–5)

- Deuteronomy is renewed covenant love for a new generation.
- Before entering comfort, they must remember faithfulness.

II. The Original Generation - Tent Life — When Fear Shrinks God (Deut 1:26–32)

- “You murmured in your tents...”
- Fear interpreted hardship as hatred.
- God fought for you (v.30).
- God carried you like a father (v.31).
- God will make a way — Do not fear. Love Him.

III. The Next Generation - House Life — When Blessing Breeds Entitlement (Deut 6:10–12; 8:11–18)

- Cities you did not build. Wells you did not dig. Vineyards you did not plant.
- “My power and the might of my hand...”
- God made a way — Do not be entitled. Love Him.

IV. The Shema — Love for All Generations (Deut 6:4–9)

- “You shall love the LORD your God...”
- The Shema is God-love passed down.
