**The Beginning of God’s Story |**

*Genesis reveals God as Creator and shows where His plan of redemption begins.*

**Author: Moses |**

*Genesis is traditionally attributed to Moses, whom Jesus affirmed as writing about Him. (John 5:46)*

**Date: 15th–13th Century BC |**

*Written during Israel’s wilderness years, Genesis shapes a redeemed people’s identity.*

**Audience: The People of Israel |**

*Given to a nation rescued from Egypt, Genesis provides Israel’s origin and calling.*

**Purpose: Creation, Fall, and Promise |**

*Genesis explains humanity’s brokenness and God’s promise to bring blessing through His chosen people.*

### 2. Fall (Genesis 3–11)

*Sin breaks God's design and spreads death and disorder.*

### 3. Promise (Genesis 12–45)

### 4. Hope (Genesis 46–50)

*God turns human evil toward His good purposes.*

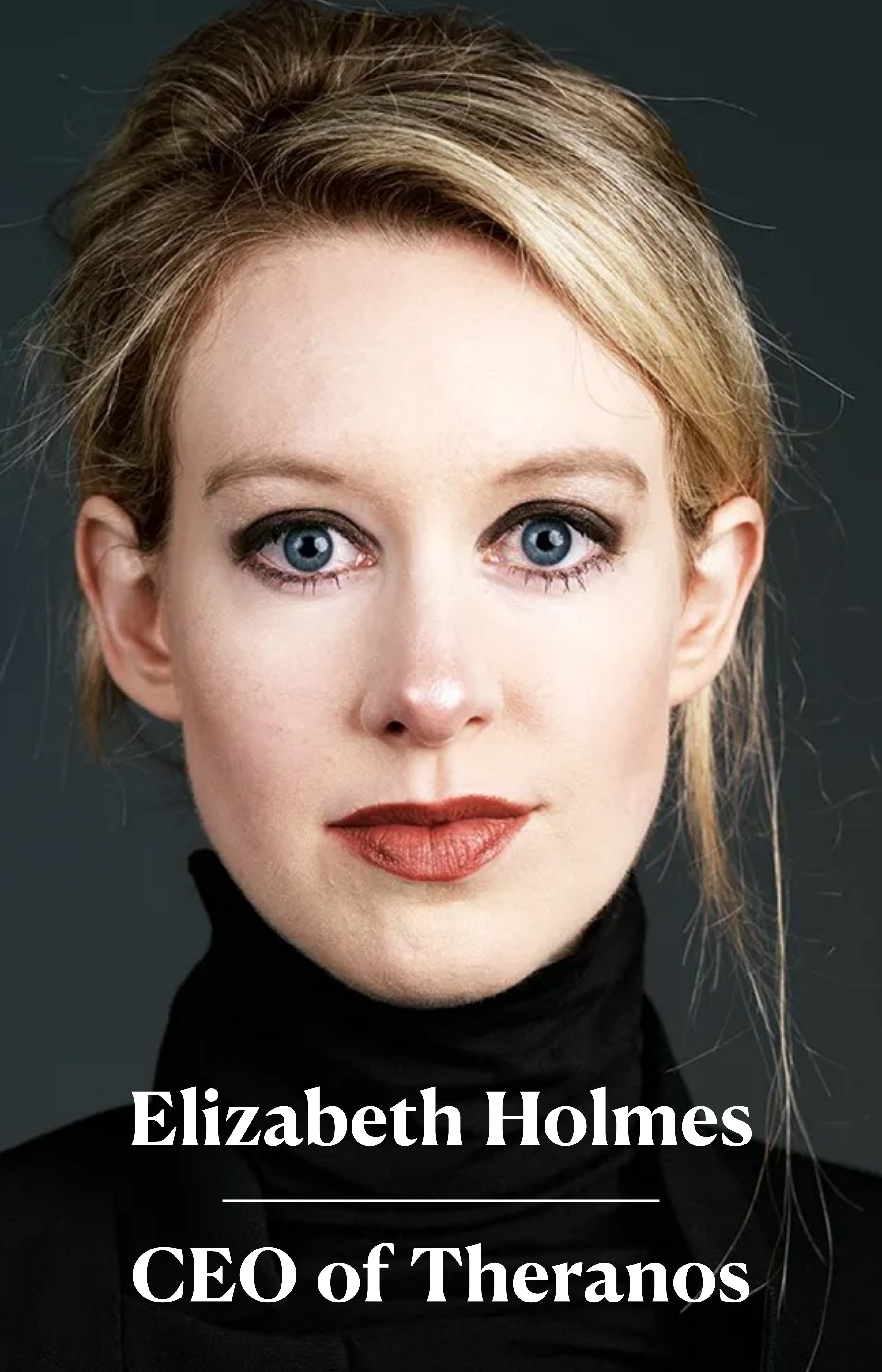
