THE CALL | Discover your Call

1. Lifelong experience

- 2. Three signals
 - •What comes naturally?
 - •What do you do that consistently helps others?
 - •What requires sacrificing time, comfort, or resources?
- **3. A discipler** Profiles and assessments are useful, but one of the best tools is a discipler—a spiritual guide who speaks truth into your life.

THE CALL | Work paired with Rest

VI2-I3 // And the Lord said to Moses, "You are to speak to the people of Israel and say, 'Above all you shall keep my Sabbaths, for this is a sign between me and you throughout your generations, that you may know that I, the Lord, sanctify you."

THE CALL | Work paired with Rest

- Before the Law (Exodus 16 tied to manna)
- Within the Law (Exodus 20, 23 creation and justice)
- At the climax of the tabernacle instructions (Exodus 31 as a covenant sign)
- After the golden calf (Exodus 34–35 reaffirmed before tabernacle building)
